


BucksAnywhere on Mac

Please note that the software available for your personal device is not the same as the software available for computer labs workstations. Some software license agreements are only available on Elon-owned devices. If you have a University owned device that needs the same access as the computer lab workstation, please submit a request to the IT Service Desk.


1. Install the AppsAnywhere client and Parallels Client

- Open your preferred web browser
- Go to <https://bucksanywhere.bucks.ac.uk>
- Enter your Bucks email address and password
- Click **It's my first time using AppsAnywhere on this device. Let's go.** The AppsAnywhere client install dialog box will appear. Click **Next** through the installation guide. At the conclusion of the installation, click **Close**



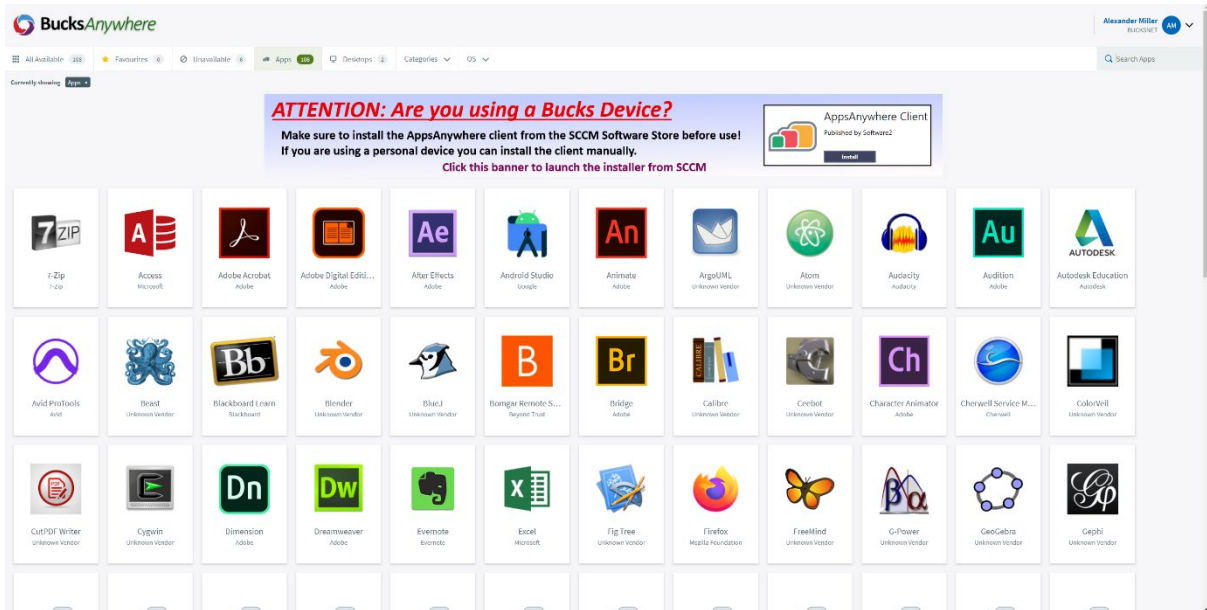
Your download has started.

To access AppsAnywhere, just install the software...

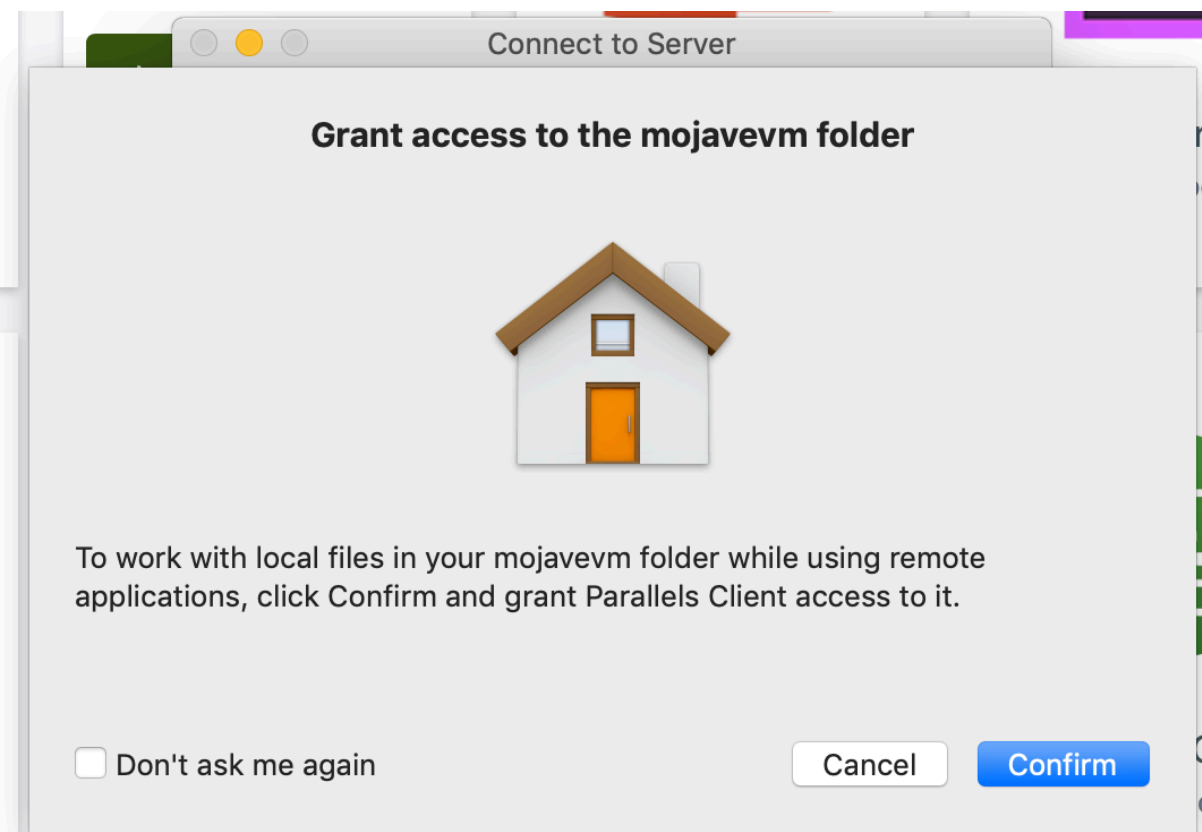


- 1 The download should start automatically.
(If it hasn't after 5 seconds, **click here**).
- 2 When the download has finished, click '**Run**' to launch the software.
- 3 Click '**Next**' until '**Done**' appears.

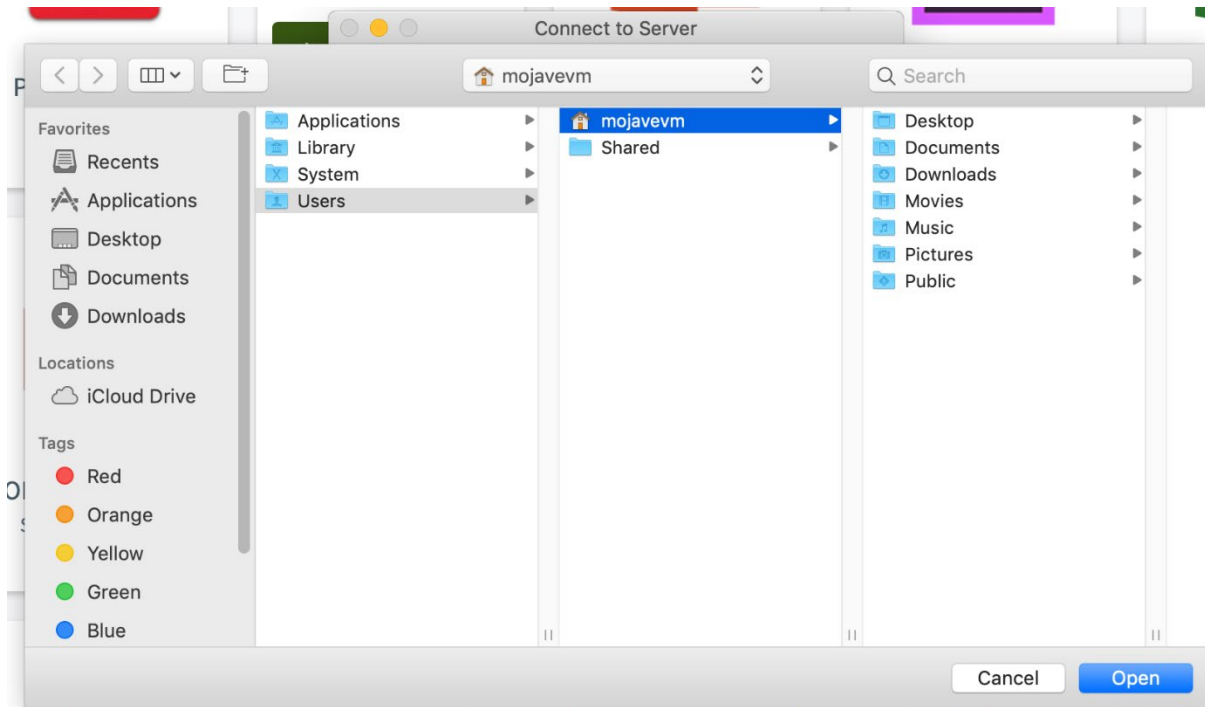
Done *Only click Done once you've completed the installation.*



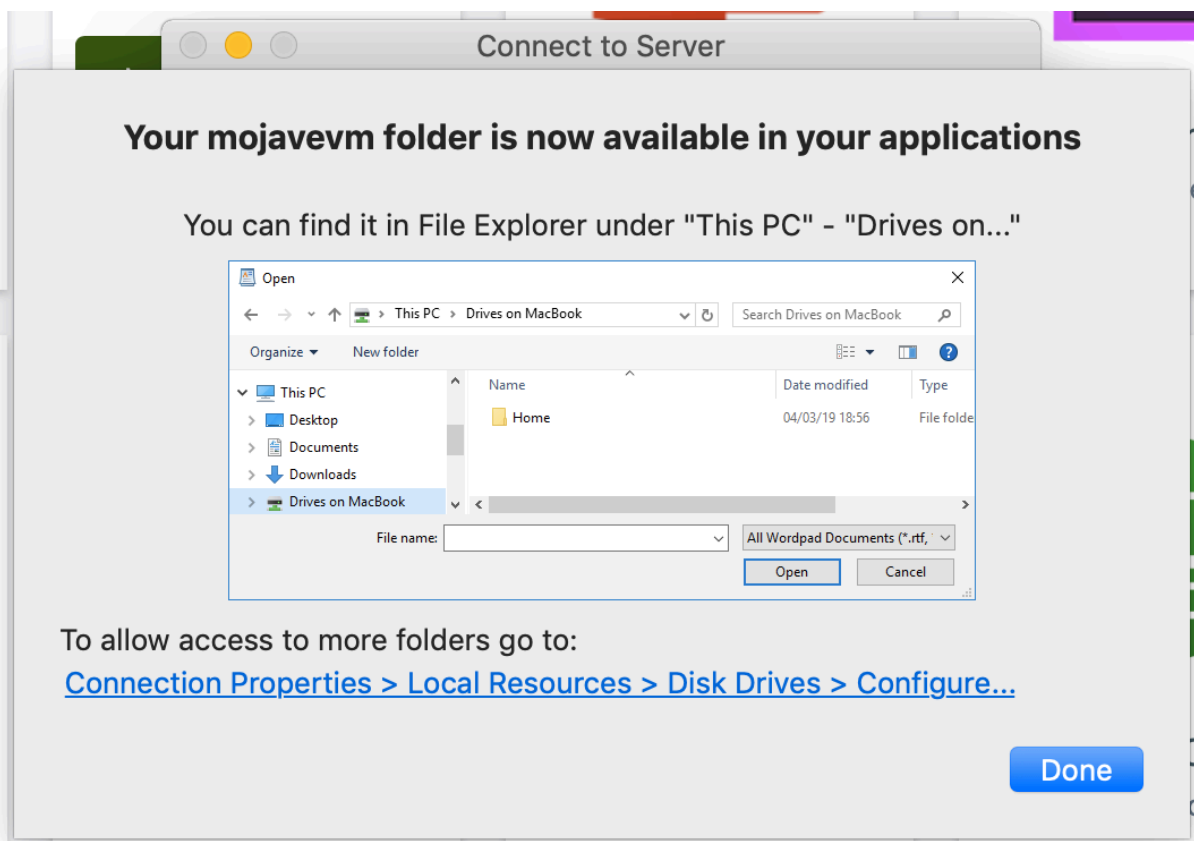
2. AppsAnywhere will request access to your files or folder so that it can open documents for each application that you use.



Select the location of your files (typically the house icon plus your username) and open.



Select "Done" to confirm. To allow additional access, click the blue link.



3. The app that you launched will run in a Windows environment in the Parallels client. If you get issues with this, please contact the IT Service Desk.

4. To open documents from your Mac in the application, you can navigate to This PC on the Parallels client. Once there, look under the "Devices and Drives" heading - you should see a

drive called "**Drives on [HEMNXXXX] -**" with some numbers at the end. You can click there to find files from your Mac to open using AppsAnywhere programs.
