









Digital Services Quick Start Guide

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|  | <p>Get your BNU Username & Password – Your username is your 8 digit BNU student ID followed by @bucks.ac.uk (e.g. 20905674@bucks.ac.uk). To find out how to activate your account or change your password go to mypassword.bucks.ac.uk. Use your username and password to access University systems and services.</p> |
|  | <p>Secure your Account – To access your emails or e-learning systems you need to register for a cyber security feature called Multifactor Authentication (MFA). MFA helps to keep your University account safe by ensuring that only you can log into it. MFA is quick to set up and only needs to be done once – for step by step instructions on how to register for MFA and a list of FAQs click here.</p> |
|  | <p>Access your Student Email – All University communication is sent to your University email address, so you need to check your email often (daily in term time). You can access your email using outlook.office365.com/OWA/bucks.ac.uk. Login using your username and password.</p> |
|  | <p>Get Enrolled – You will receive an email inviting you to enrol online using the BNU Connect portal. It is important to complete your enrolment as soon as you get the email invitation so that you can access your timetable and be able to start your course. To complete your enrolment access the BNU Connect Portal.</p> |
|  | <p>Access Office 365 – Go to office.com to access Office Online. This gives you access to applications such as Word, PowerPoint, Teams, Excel and more.</p> |
|  | <p>Access Blackboard – This is the Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) which provides access to online learning resources for your course. To access Blackboard go to my.bucks.ac.uk, or access the student area through the link at the bottom of the BNU web page. Login using your BNU username and password.</p> |
