

Buckinghamshire New University Booking terms and conditions for Halls of Residence

We can only offer accommodation to applicants who have chosen Bucks as their first choice and returning students. We cannot accommodate insurance offers or applicants who have not yet accepted their place.

Halls are prioritised for first-year students; however, there is an allocation for returning students. Returning students will be vetted in terms of previous behaviour and previous payment history.

We can't guarantee your first choice of room, but we'll do our best to meet your requirements from the choices you've made.

Once accepted you may not be able to change your room until after the start of the contract and transfers are not guaranteed.

If we can't accept or process your application we'll contact you.

If you apply as a group, we cannot guarantee we can accommodate you as such, but will do our best to do so.

If you decline the room we offer you, we cannot guarantee that we can allocate you another room.

If you owe money to the Accommodation Service, you will not be offered a room.

Should you declare a disability, the Accommodation Service will pass details to the Disability Service.

We may turn down your booking if we don't have any rooms available when you apply.

If you are on placement for part of the academic year and think that you might not want accommodation for the whole year, think carefully! Once you have booked accommodation we will not be able to release you due to a placement commitment.
