At BNU we pride ourselves on the support we offer our students to succeed in their academic learning and on creating graduates ready for employment and career progression. About Your Programme

A warm welcome to the **Level 6 BSc Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship (RNDA) Programme**. This programme is a work-based programme that integrates academic and work-based learning through collaboration between your Employers and the University. This programme enables you to develop knowledge, skills and professional values required to deliver compassionate, safe and effective nursing care as an autonomous, reflective practitioner.

On successful completion of your programme you will be qualified to deliver a wide range of clinical and care skills and will be able to demonstrate appropriate values and behaviours, underpinned by a systematic knowledge base training.

You will be expected to work hard, both during and outside of your timetabled hours, to enable you to fulfil the requirements and successfully meet the demands of this programme. To help you with this, the academic team and the Apprenticeship Hub will be monitoring your progress through the programme, through your APTEM portfolio and Tripartite progress meetings. Help and support will also be provided by your nominated Apprenticeship Partnership Manager (APM).

Your Induction

Your induction will take place on **Thursday 4th January 2024, 9am – 5pm**, at our **Uxbridge Campus, 106 Oxford Road, Uxbridge, UB8 1NA**. On arriving at our campus please make your way to our main reception where you will be met and shown to your room. The day will start with an induction to the programme and the academic Team along with delivery of all the key information needed to start your learning journey.

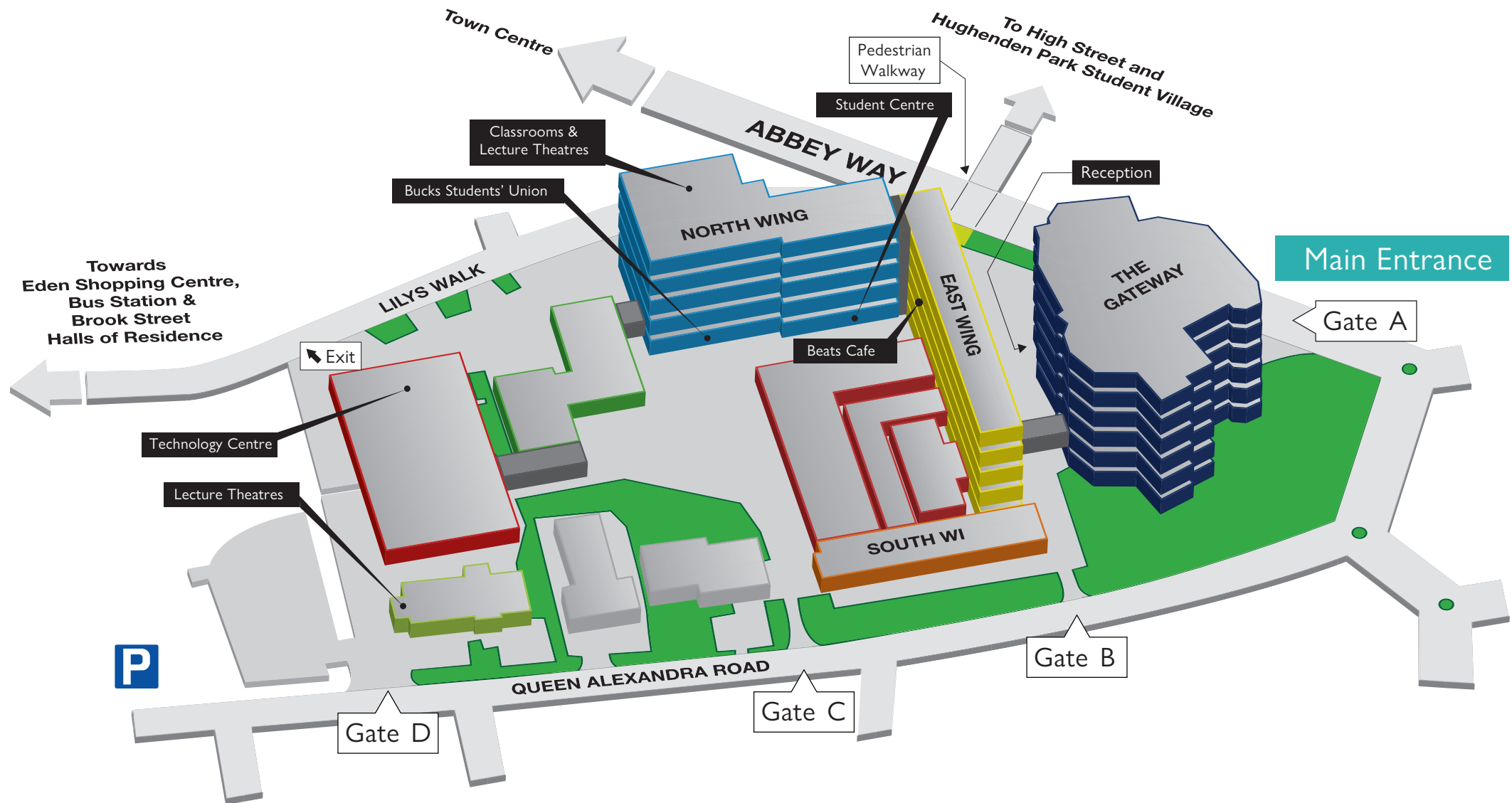
By rail

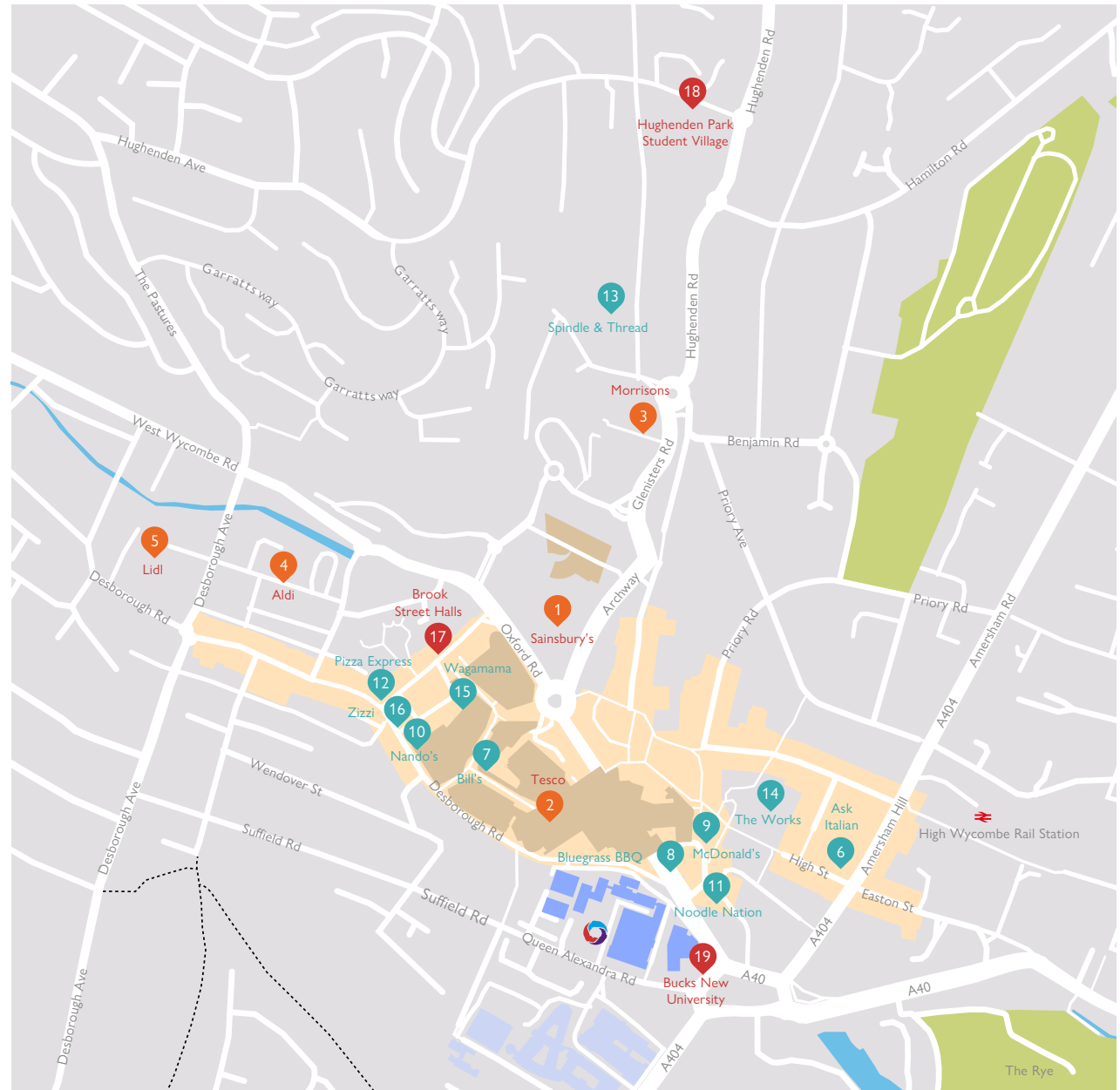

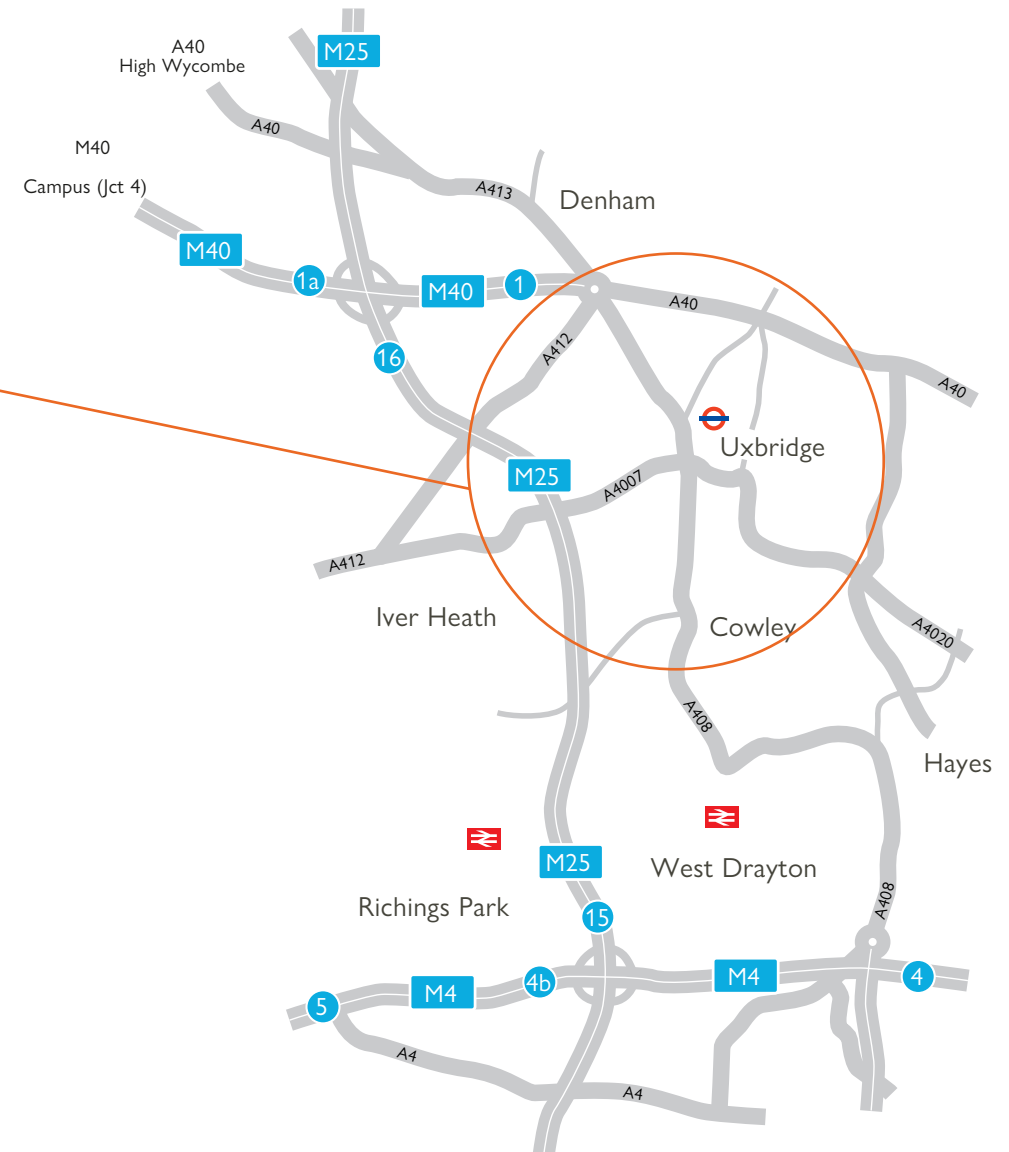
By tube

Metropolitan or Piccadilly Line to Uxbridge. The campus is approximately five minutes' walk, and quarter of a mile from the station.

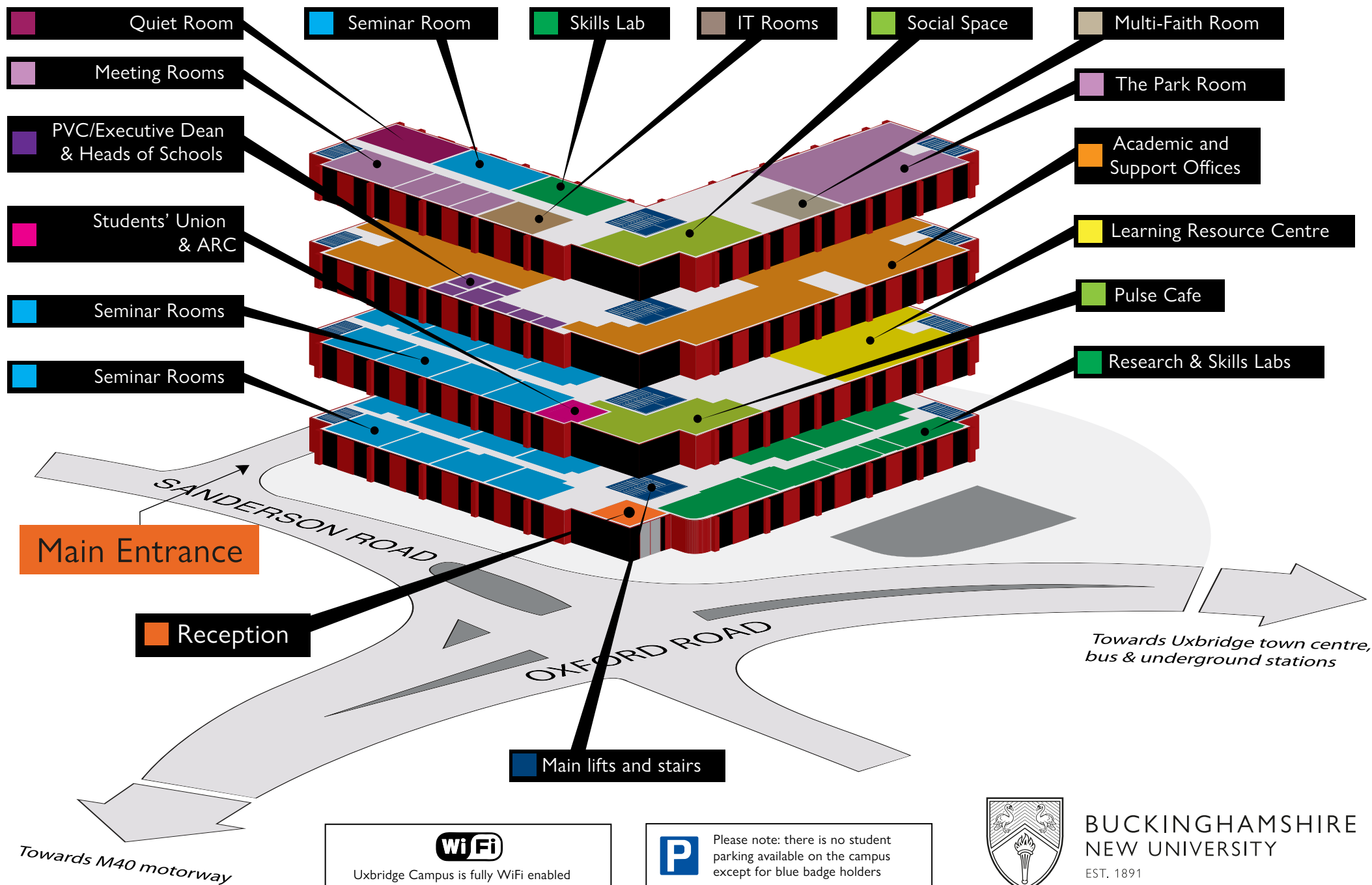
By bus
