ABOUT YOUR PROGRAMME

A warm welcome to the Level 7 MSc Advanced Clinical Practitioner (ACP) Apprenticeship and Non-apprentice Programme. This is a work-based programme that integrates academic and work-based learning through collaboration between your work place and the University. This programme enables you to develop the knowledge, skills, and professional values required to deliver compassionate, safe and effective care as an autonomous, reflective practitioner. Upon successful completion of your programme you will be qualified to deliver a wide range of clinical and care skills and will be able to demonstrate appropriate values and behaviours, underpinned by a systematic, knowledge base training.

You will be expected to work hard, both during and outside of your timetabled hours, to enable you to fulfil the requirements and successfully meet the demands of this programme. To help you with this, the academic team, Student Learning & Achievement team and the Apprenticeship Hub are here to support your progress through the programme.

YOUR INDUCTION

The programme will start on **Thursday 4th January** at our Uxbridge Campus (106 Oxford Road, Uxbridge, UB8 1NA). The day will start with an induction to the programme, ACP Team and Apprentice Hub team, along with the delivery of all the key information needed to start your learning journey.






By tube


By rail




