STARTING AT BNU

ENROLMENT

ID / Qualifications Check

You will be required to show proof of ID when you start with us. This can be:

- Current passport
- EU / EEA National Identity Card
- Birth / Adoption certificate

You will also require proof of your qualifications. Please make sure you have these documents available prior to joining us.

Photograph

You will need to email us a head and shoulders photograph of yourself before you start at BNU. This photo should be in a JPEG format and sent to students@bnu.ac.uk with the subject line "Student ID." Please include the following information in your email:

- Your student ID (if you know it)
- Your full name (include all forenames and surname)
- Your date of birth
- The name of the course you will be starting



ABOUT YOUR COURSE

Cyber-attacks comprise the main security issues facing organisations in the information age. Today, all organisations operate with a potential information security risk and will need to implement strategies to protect their IT systems and data. Although society has become increasingly reliant upon information technology and Internet based services, cyber security skills and capability are not currently increasing at a comparable rate.

The UK is a world leader in the cyber security sector, with the demand for new talent only set to grow. This growth requires a sustained supply of competent cyber security professionals who have achieved the requisite standards and certification.

The BSc (Hons) Cyber Security course will provide you with a fundamental understanding of how to protect organisations, networks, IT systems and individuals against cyber-attacks and cyber threats.

Your course has been developed to provide a specific opportunity to enter an educational programme in an increasingly vital subject area. The course aims to develop and prepare you to become a cyber-security professional, or to develop new skill sets that may also enable you to consider alternative employment roles in IT services as a whole.

During the course, you will learn the underpinning areas of software and networked systems as well as developing specialist skills in cyber security, risk and information management. You will also learn to use a wide range of cyber security related tools and techniques, alongside technical skills in computer programming, software engineering, cloud and database development.

Qualified cyber security professionals are currently in high demand by business, government and law enforcement agencies across the globe. Graduating students from the course will have gained the fundamental skills and knowledge necessary to quickly adopt the emerging technologies and concepts in this fast-changing field, alongside the professional and business skills, techniques and ways of thinking needed to be able to align technical security requirements with business needs.

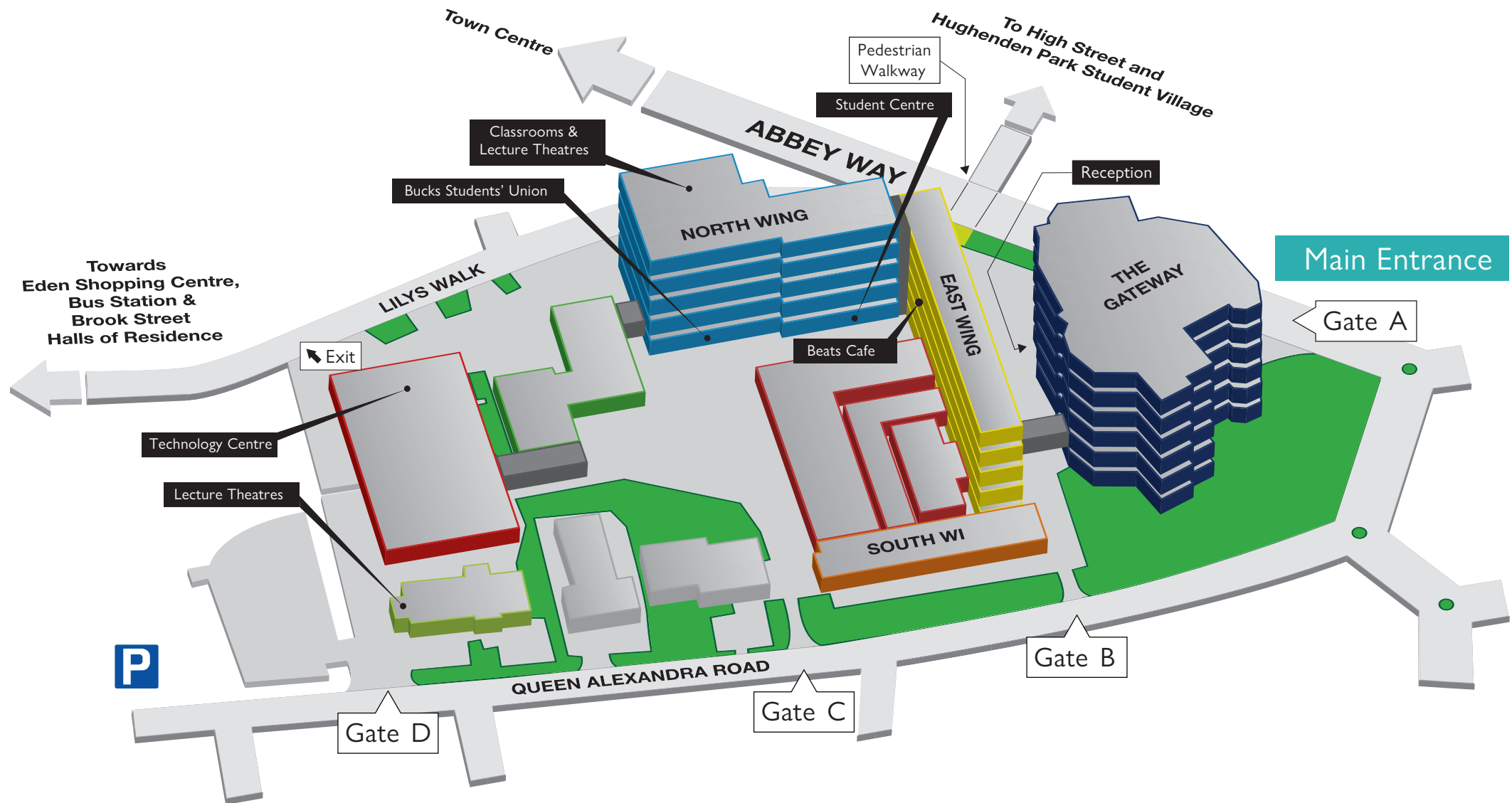
By rail

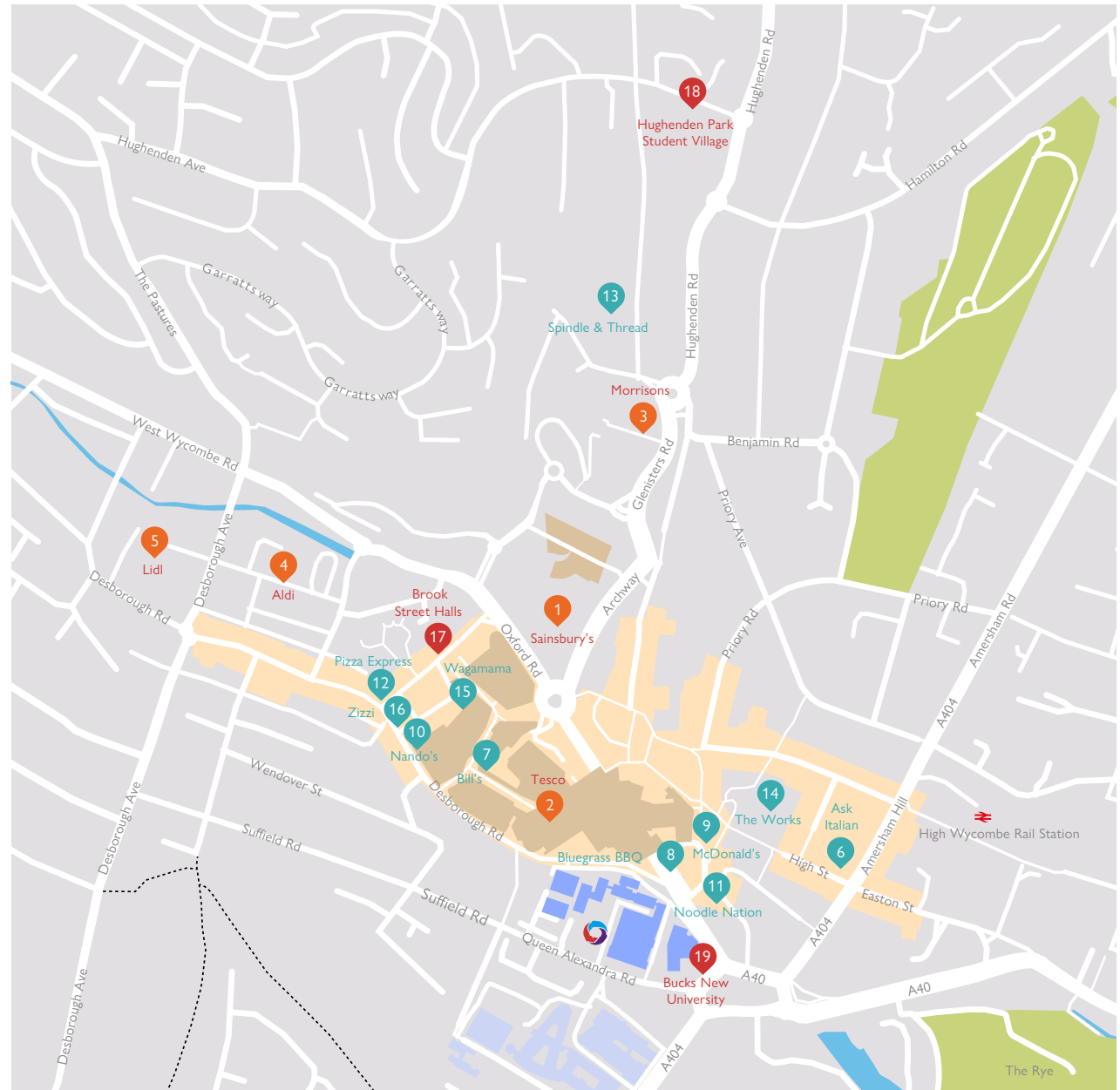
