



MA Interior and Spatial Design

Additional Course Costs

There are costs associated with all studies, additional to the tuition fee, which require consideration, when planning and budgeting for expenditure. Costs are indicative and for the total length of the course shown unless otherwise stated and will increase with inflation; depending on the programme they may include equipment, printing, project materials and placement activities.

Additional course costs for MA Interior and Spatial Design are outlined below:

Books and other Texts

Students will be required to purchase texts and journals to support their study programme. The minimum, average cost of books for students studying on a degree course is assumed as £100 per year.

Printing

Even if the course is taught online we would like to stress the importance of checking on paper the final outcome of your work. We recommend a minimum budget of £50 per year for basic printing/photocopying costs.

Equipment/Materials

Students will be required to have a pc or a laptop with the relevant software installed. The cost for this will vary depending on specs but a selection could be between £200 - £1000. The computer needs to be provided of a working camera and microphone. The students will also need to have a photographic machine or a telephone with a working camera to take pictures of their models or sketches and share them online with the tutor.

Any materials required for developing the work will need to be covered by the student; these costs can vary depending on what materials are required but project costs are estimated up to £100 per year to produce sketches and study models.

Graduation

Graduation costs per student are estimated at £100 - £200 total. This is an optional cost for all students, as attending graduation is not a requirement in order to have a degree conferred.
