ABOUT YOUR COURSE

A warm welcome to the Level 6 BSc Registered Nurse Degree Apprenticeship Programme!

This programme is a work-based programme that integrates academic and work-based learning through collaboration between your Employer and the University. This programme enables you to develop knowledge, skills and professional values required to deliver compassionate, safe and effective nursing care as an autonomous, reflective practitioner.

On successful completion of your programme you will be qualified to deliver a wide range of clinical and care skills and will be able to demonstrate appropriate values and behaviours, underpinned by systematic, knowledge-based training.

You will be expected to work hard, both during and outside of your timetabled hours, to enable you to fulfil the requirements and successfully meet the demands of this programme. To help you with this, the academic team and the Apprenticeship Hub will be monitoring your progress through the programme through your APTEM portfolio and Tripartite progress meetings. Help and support will also be provided by your nominated Apprenticeship Partnership Manager (APM).
